

2012 – Woodinville Police Citizens Academy

The Woodinville, Kenmore, and Shoreline Police Departments, along with the King County Sheriff's Office, are sponsoring their annual Citizens Academy. The Academy is a 10-week course that begins March 21 and runs through May 23. Classes are located at the Kenmore City Hall: 18120 68th Avenue NE, in Kenmore, WA. The classes are held on Wednesday evenings from 6:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m.

The Police Citizens Academy is a great way to gain a better understanding of police work and the resources available to them. Those who complete the course are eligible to sign up to ride with an officer during part of a patrol shift.

The course covers a variety of topics including Defensive Tactics, K9, Major Accident Investigations, Drug Investigations, Homicide and Major Crimes, Automatic Fingerprint Identification System (AFIS), Guardian One Helicopter and Marine Patrol.

The Woodinville Police Department has 10 openings available for residents of the City of Woodinville. Registration and an application are required.
