

# How to Enable JavaScript in a Browser

After following the appropriate instructions, click refresh, or close and reopen your browser.

## Microsoft Internet Explorer 7.x, 6.x, and 5.x

1. Open Internet Explorer.
2. Select *Tools / Internet Options*.
3. Select the *Security* tab.
4. Click *Internet* (if 6.x or 5.x)
5. Click the *Custom* level button at bottom right.
6. Scroll down to the Scripting category; check  
*Active Scripting*,  
*Allow paste options via script (if found)*  
*Scripting of Java applets (if found)*
7. Click *OK*, *Yes (if asked)*, and *OK* close out.

## Microsoft Internet Explorer 4.x:

1. Select *View / Internet Options*
2. Click the *Security* tab
3. Click *Custom*
4. Click *Settings*
5. scroll down to locate *Scripting*
6. Click *Enable for Active Scripting*
7. Click *OK*, then click the *Reload* button

## Microsoft Internet Explorer 3.x:

1. Select *View / Options*
2. Click *Security*
3. check *Enable Java Programs*
4. Click *OK*
5. Click the *Reload* button

## Firefox Mozilla

1. Select *Edit / Preferences*
2. Double click *Advanced* in the *Category* list.
3. Select *Scripts & Plugins* from the menu.
4. Under the *Enable JavaScript for* section, check the box next to *Navigator*.

5. Check the boxes under *Allow scripts to* section that you want to allow.
6. Click *OK*

### **Netscape 4.0 or higher:**

1. Select *Edit / Preferences*
2. Click *Advanced*
3. Select *Scripts & Plugins*
4. Under the *Enable JavaScript for* section, check the box next to *Navigator*.
5. Check the boxes under *Allow scripts to* section that you want to allow.
6. Click *OK*.

### **Firefox 2.x:**

1. Select *Tools / Options*.
2. Click on the *Content* icon.
3. Check the box next to *Enable JavaScript*.

### **Firefox 1.x:**

1. Select *Tools / Options*.
2. Click *Web Features* in the *Options* list.
3. Check the box next to *Enable JavaScript*.
4. Click the *Advanced* button to open the *Advanced JavaScript Options* box.
5. Check the boxes under *Allow scripts to* section that you want to allow.
6. Click *OK* then *OK*.

### **Opera 9.x:**

1. On the *Tools* menu, click *Preferences*.
2. Click *Content* in the *Preferences* list.
3. Check the box next to *Enable JavaScript*.
4. Click the *JavaScript Options* button to open the *JavaScript Options* box.
5. Check the boxes that you want to allow.
6. Click *OK* then *OK*.

## **America Online (Windows)**

1. Select *Settings* and click on *Preferences*
2. Select *Internet Properties*.
3. Select *Custom Level*.
4. Scroll down the Custom Level screen to *Scripting*.
5. *Enable Active Scripting*.
6. Select *OK* then *Yes* that you want to change the security settings.
7. Select *OK*.
8. Close the *Preferences* window.
9. Click the *Reload* button in the browser's row of icons in the EGXpress window.

## **America Online (Mac OS X)**

1. Select *AOL* from the menu bar and click on *Preferences*
2. Click on the *www* icon in the scrolling list on the left side.
3. Click on the *Content* tab.
4. Click on checkbox next to *Enable JavaScript*.
5. Click the *OK* button.
6. Click the *Reload* button in the browser's row of icons in the EGXpress window.

## **Safari for Macintosh**

1. Select *Safari* from the menu bar and click on *Preferences*
2. Click on the *Security* icon.
3. Click on checkbox next to Enable JavaScript.
4. Close that window.
5. Click the *Reload* button in the browser's row of icons in the EGXpress window.
