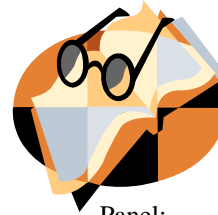

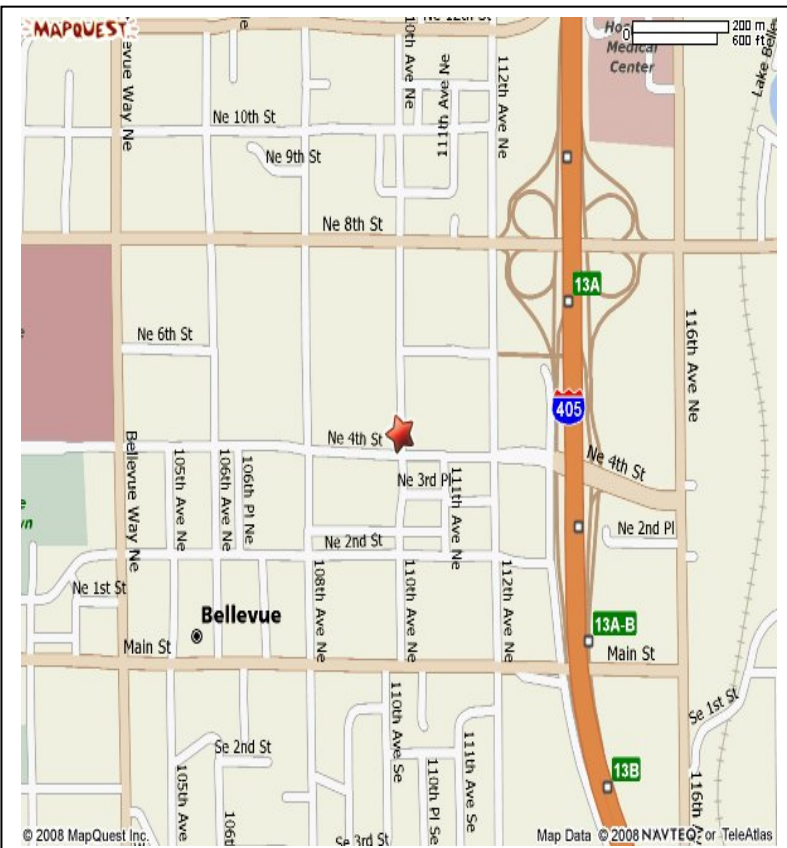

→If you are walking, the pedestrian entrance (plaza) is located 110<sup>th</sup> Ave. NE. When you enter the building, you will be on the second floor the Council Chambers is located down one level, on the 1<sup>st</sup> floor.

→IF you are driving, the visitor parking entrance is located on 110<sup>th</sup> Ave NE. After you park and enter the building, you will be on the first floor. Ask Service First staff for further assistance or questions.

→Parking is available on a first-come, first served basis and is free. Ask Service First staff to validate your ticket.

→From Seattle via Hwy 520: Take State Route 520 east over the Evergreen Point Bridge to I-405 south. Go south on I-405 and then Exit 13A West (NE 4<sup>th</sup> Street). Go one block and make a right turn on 110<sup>th</sup> Ave NE. Proceed to the City Hall visitor parking entrance on the right.

→From Seattle via I-90: Take I-90 East over Lake Washington. Merge north onto I-405 (Exit 10). Take Exit 13A West (NE 4<sup>th</sup> Street westbound). Turn right on 110<sup>th</sup> Ave. NE. Proceed to the City Hall parking entrance on the right.
