

ORDINANCE NO. 406

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON, LEVYING THE GENERAL TAXES FOR THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING JANUARY 1, 2006, ON ALL PROPERTY, BOTH REAL AND PERSONAL, IN SAID CITY WHICH IS SUBJECT TO TAXATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF PAYING SUFFICIENT REVENUE TO CARRY ON THE SEVERAL DEPARTMENTS OF SAID CITY FOR THE ENSUING YEAR AS REQUIRED BY LAW.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Woodinville has met and considered its budget for the calendar year 2006; and

WHEREAS, city operating expenses such as labor, fuel and supplies have increased by 2.3% over the past years, as measured by the consumer price index for Washington (CPI-W) from June 2004 to June 2005; and

WHEREAS, in public hearings before the City Council, Woodinville residents and law enforcement officials have testified that property crimes have increased in the city in 2005, frequently diverting police resources from ongoing traffic safety; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Woodinville after hearing and after duly considering all relevant evidence and testimony presented, determined that the City of Woodinville requires a regular levy in the amount of \$2,707,119 which includes an increase in property tax revenue from the previous year from amounts resulting from the addition of new construction and improvements to property and any increase in the value of state-assessed property, and amounts authorized by law as a result of annexations that have occurred and refunds made, in order to discharge the expected expenses and obligations of the City and in its best interest; and

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council of the City of Woodinville resolves that an increase in the regular property tax levy is hereby authorized for the 2006 levy in the amount of \$26,000 which is a percentage increase of 1% from the previous year. This increase is exclusive of additional revenue resulting from the addition of new construction and improvements to property and any increase in the value

of state-assessed property, and any amounts resulting from any annexations that have occurred and refunds made.

Section 2. Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Woodinville that an increase in the regular property tax levy is hereby authorized for the 2006 levy in the amount of \$93,140, which is revenue resulting from the addition of new construction and improvements to property and any increase in the value of state-assessed property, and any additional amounts resulting from any annexations that have occurred and refunds made within the city over the past year.

Section 3. The City Council of the City of Woodinville resolves that the \$26,000 increase in the regular property tax levy for the 2006 levy, which is a percentage increase of 1% from the previous year, shall be appropriated within the general operating budget for the exclusive purpose of traffic enforcement; PROVIDED that funds shall be used for a one-year contract with one or more law enforcement agencies for traffic enforcement on city streets, with emphasis on pedestrian safety near schools and speed enforcement in neighborhoods.

Section 4. This ordinance shall be certified to the proper County officials, as provided by law, and taxes here levied shall be collected to pay to the City of Woodinville at the time and in the manner provided by the laws of the State of Washington for the collection of taxes for non-charter code cities.

Section 5. Effective Date. This ordinance, or a summary thereof consisting of the title, shall be published in the official newspaper of the City, and shall take effect and be in full force five (5) days after publication.

Section 6. Severability. If any clause, sentence, section or provision of this ordinance is ultimately held invalid by a court, tribunal, or agency with jurisdiction, such invalidity shall not affect any other clause, sentence, section or provision hereof.
