

ORDINANCE NO. 464

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE,
WASHINGTON, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 453 TO
ESTABLISH COMPENSATION RANGE FOR ASSISTANT
PUBLIC WORKS DIRECTOR.**

WHEREAS, the City Council previously adopted Ordinance No. 453 to establish pay, benefit and classification structure for 2008; and

WHEREAS, the City now intends to reclassify two vacant Senior Engineer positions; one to an existing lower job classification and pay range and one to a new job classification at a higher pay range; and

WHEREAS, the City Council must establish pay ranges for new position classes;


**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE,
WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. Ordinance No. 453 shall be amended as shown in Exhibit A, to add the position title of Assistant Public Works Director (Pay Range L).

Section 2. The effective date of these new pay ranges shall be July 1, 2008 and shall continue until amended by action of the City Council.


