



City of Woodinville Political Sign Code Requirements

Campaign season is upon us and the City seeks your cooperation in displaying political signs in accordance with the code requirements summarized below:

- ◆ Off-premises political signs that do not exceed four (4) square feet in area may be displayed in the public right-of-way.
- ◆ Off-premises political signs that do not exceed 32 square feet in area and six (6) feet in height may be displayed on private property.
- ◆ Sign permits are required for free standing political signs with a height greater than 4 feet and signs made of wood or metal which are attached to buildings.
- ◆ Political signs, posters or bills may be displayed from the closing date for filing for an election until seven (7) days after the general election.
- ◆ No political sign can be posted, painted or affixed to any streetlight, crosswalk, curb, lamppost, street sign, utility pole, tree, hydrant or public building.
- ◆ Political signs may be placed on parking strips, the periphery of the public right-of-way and other portions not used for vehicular or pedestrian travel.
- ◆ No political sign may be placed within the right-of-way that creates a safety hazard for pedestrians or vehicles.
