

SALMON EDUCATION KITS 2009

Woodinville Parks and Recreation is pleased to offer free Salmon Education Kits to our community educators and citizens. Kits are available for check-out beginning September 7th and concluding on November 12th. Accommodations may be made if you would like to use a kit at another time during the year.



This comprehensive kit includes books, posters, videos, overhead transparencies, ready-to-use classroom activities, teacher background resources, reproducible activity sheets, and materials for students to take home. Also included are suggested uses for the various kit materials. The Salmon Kits have been designed for 4th and 6th grade classes, but are easy to adapt to provide younger or older students with basic salmon and watershed knowledge.

The Salmon Education Kit was developed for educators as part of continued efforts to protect and restore wild salmon runs in our streams and rivers. The goal of this program is to encourage a better understanding of salmon biology and habitat needs, and the relationships between water quality, watershed health, and salmon survival. Some of the topics that are covered by the materials in the kit are:

- Salmon life cycle
- Salmon and the Endangered Species Act
- Watersheds
- Salmon species identification
- Salmon migration
- Water Cycle
- Stream surveys and stewardship
