- League Rules are available on City website. **SEE LEAGUE RULES FOR COMPLETE DETAILS.**
- \*All players must complete and sign a Registration Form and be on the Official Team Roster to participate. Registration Forms and Rosters must be on file with the recreation office prior to participation.
- **SINGLE PAYMENT ONLY FOR TEAM.** Full payment required for registration to secure team's spot.
- Completed Team Roster due at Coaches' Meeting. Roster additions must be made BEFORE start of mid-season game. Completed and signed Registration Forms MUST accompany all Roster updates. Official Roster updates will be circulated to all coaches to verify eligibility of all players on all teams for all games. Coaches may challenge eligibility based off Roster. Only eligible players may play.
- Players may appear on only one Official Roster for each League and be at least 18 years old to participate.
- At least 10 players required to register and to start season, with a minimum of 4 players that are male/female. Playing 10 players, a 4:6 ratio is minimum. Eight (8) players (4:4) minimum for game play. Roster size is limited to 20 players. Better to list players not needed than to need them and not have them.

Information Regarding Zachery Lystedt's Law  
Head Injuries in Youth Sports

Youth sports pose an inherent risk of injury to young athletes. Recent cases, such as the death of a seventeen year old football player in Spokane Valley, confirm that athletes can suffer potentially catastrophic brain injury during athletic competition. This year, the Washington State Legislature adopted Zachery Lystedt's Law, which requires that school and private nonprofit community athletics programs using school facilities restrict participation by athletes who may have suffered a concussion. The Law mandates the removal of a player suspected of having a concussion from competition or practice; written clearance to return to competition or practice from a trained health care provider trained in evaluation and management of concussions; education and training of coaches in how to recognize and respond to possible symptoms and signs of a concussion; notification to youth athletes and parents about the nature and risk of head injury and concussions; and a written acknowledgement by youth athletes and parents that they have been provided an education sheet about the risks of concussions.

Woodinville community athletics programs are not operated by private, nonprofit youth programs or school districts, and are therefore, not directly subject to Zachery Lystedt's Law.

However, the City of Woodinville Parks and Recreation Department will distribute this information sheet to all community athletics programs coaches and instructors. The City will also make this information available to participants by posting the information on the city web site in order to encourage education regarding the possible symptoms and signs of a concussion. ## REFUNDS...

**100% refund:** If class is cancelled by Parks and Recreation due to insufficient enrollment or facility problem.

**100% less a \$10.00 processing fee:** If your request to withdraw is received a minimum of 5 business days prior to the first class.

Refunds take approximately 10 business days from date of cancellation.

**No Refunds:** For programs costing under \$10.01 (unless cancelled by Parks and Recreation). No refunds are given for participants removed from class for disciplinary issues.

**Other:** Medical injuries or other extenuating circumstances are handled on a case by case basis. Documentation of circumstance may be required.

## TRANSFERS...

Transfers from one class to another may be accommodated within the first week of class, depending on enrollment.
