

ORDINANCE NO. 396

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON, AMENDING THE PARKS, RECREATION AND OPEN SPACE PLAN INCORPORATED BY REFERENCE INTO CHAPTER 7 OF THE WOODINVILLE COMPREHENSIVE PLAN UNDER RESOLUTION NO. 145; SETTING FORTH FINDINGS IN SUPPORT OF SAID ACTION; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Woodinville City Council adopted Ordinance No. 157, adopting the City's GMA Comprehensive Plan on June 24, 1996; and

WHEREAS, the Parks, Recreation and Open Space Plan was adopted by reference into the Comprehensive Plan through Resolution No. 145 on June 8, 1998; and

WHEREAS, the City of Woodinville's population, the acreage of City-owned parklands and the number and location of park facilities has changed since the adoption of the 1998 Parks, Recreation and Open Space Plan; and

WHEREAS, the park facility and population demographic changes have resulted in recreation demand differences between 1998 and the present; and

WHEREAS, the revisions to the Parks Recreation and Open Space Plan effectuated hereunder significantly implicate the Comprehensive Plan's Capital Facilities Element and are scheduled concurrently with an amendment of the City's budget pursuant to RCW 36.70A.130((2)(a)(iii)); and

WHEREAS, the Woodinville City Council has reviewed the amendment contained in Attachment A and, in light of the above, finds that it satisfies the criteria codified at WMC 21.01.170 as follows:

- A. The proposed amendment is consistent with the Growth Management Act and other applicable State laws;
- B. The proposed amendment is consistent with applicable Countywide Planning Policies;
- C. The proposed amendment is consistent with the Goals and Policies of the Comprehensive Plan; and
- D. The proposed amendment is beneficial to the City as a whole, and to the health, safety, and welfare of its residents; and

WHEREAS, numerous public hearings were held by the City of Woodinville Parks and Recreation Commission from November 2004 through April, 2005; and

Whereas, a public hearing was held by the City of Woodinville Planning Commission on April 6, 2005; and

WHEREAS, the requirements of the State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA) RCW 43.21C have been met;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Findings. The above recitals are specifically adopted by the Woodinville City Council in support of the legislative action effected by this ordinance.

Section 2. Amendment of the Parks, Recreation and Open Space Plan. The Parks, Recreation and Open Space Plan referenced in Section 7.1 and Appendix A-7.1 of the of the City of Woodinville Comprehensive Plan is hereby amended to provide in its entirety as set forth in Attachment A, incorporated by this reference as if set forth in full.

Section 3. Severability. Should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance be held invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect other provisions designations, projections demand analysis or applications of this ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are declared to be severable.

Section 4. Copy to CTED. Pursuant to RCW 36.70A.106(3), the City Clerk is directed to send a copy of the amendments to the State Department of Community, Trade, and Economic Development for its files within ten (10) days after adoption of this Ordinance.

Section 5. Effective Date. The adoption of this Ordinance, which is a power specifically delegated to the City legislative body, is not subject to referendum. This Ordinance or a summary thereof shall be published in the official newspaper of the City, and shall take effect and be in full force five (5) days after the date of publication.


