



TREE REMOVAL PERMIT APPLICATION

PLEASE SUBMIT YOUR APPLICATION WITH THESE REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

- **SITE PLAN.** If removing 3 or more trees, a site plan is required showing parcel dimensions and location of structures and trees.
- **ARBORIST REPORT.** An arborist report will be required if the tree removal is based on nuisance or hazard criteria. There is no limit on the number of hazard or nuisance trees that may be removed with an arborist report.
- **PLANTING PLAN.** If the site does not meet the minimum tree credit requirement, then a planting plan is required by Chapter 21.50 WMC. See the City of Woodinville Planting Plan Handout for more information.
- **PERMIT FEE.** A permit fee is due at the time of issuance.

WHERE CAN I FIND MORE INFORMATION?

- A property owner may remove up to **two healthy trees within a 12-month period** or four healthy trees within a 24-month period with a tree removal permit.
- There is **no limit on the number of hazard, dead, or nuisance trees** that may be removed; however, replanting may be required. **An arborist report will be required** if the tree removal is based on the nuisance or hazard criteria as specified in Woodinville Municipal Code (WMC) and the condition is not easily observed.

SITE PLAN INSTRUCTIONS

If you are removing three or more trees, a site plan is required. At a minimum, the site plan must be drawn to scale and include property boundaries, building footprints, the driveway, and the approximate location of all existing trees numbered to correspond with the completed tree inventory.

- Show all structures to scale.
- Show and label all trees
- Show the street name.

WILL MY PROPERTY MEET WOODINVILLE'S TREE CODE?

Replanting is *not* required for the first 2 single-family residential tree removal permits issued on a property. After 2 permits, the property must meet the *minimum tree density* or replant at a rate of 3 trees per 1 tree removed.

Lots in the R-1 zone must have a *minimum tree density* of 70 tree credits per acre. Lots in the R-4 through R-8 zone must have 50 tree credits per acre.

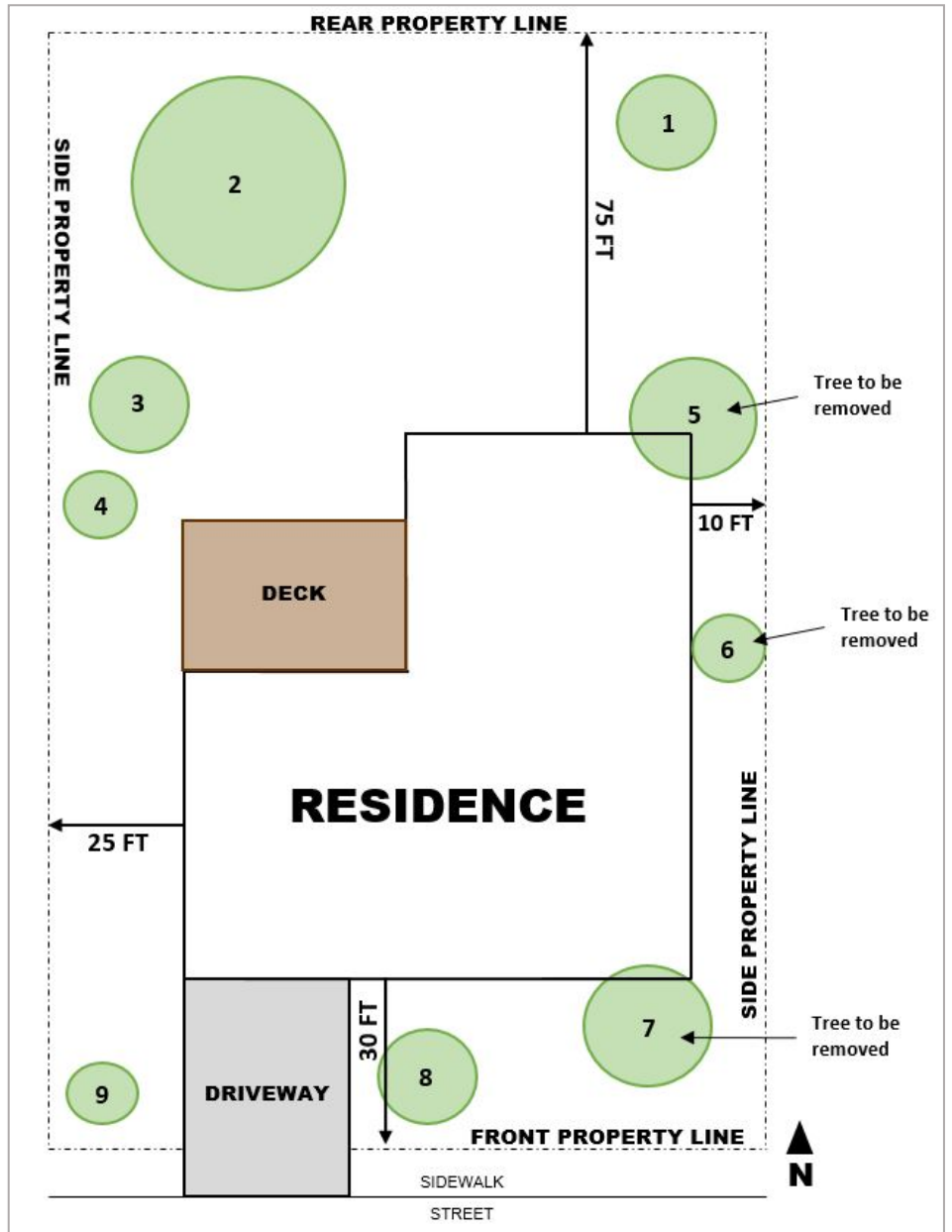
To determine if a property meets the minimum tree density, staff calculates tree credits of all trees on the site. Tree density is based off the diameter of the total number of retained or (re)planted trees.

WHAT IF MY LOT DOESN'T MEET WOODINVILLE'S TREE CODE?

If the site currently does not meet the minimum tree credits, replanting is

required. The property must replant 3 trees per each tree removed or plant trees to meet the *minimum tree density*. The tree species chosen for supplemental trees must either be trees of the same mix of species as the canopy that has been removed or as listed in the Woodinville Plant Species List. The trees must be a minimum of 2-inch caliper.

A planting plan would be required with the submittal of the permit to identify the number of trees, size, species, and location of the tree(s) to be planted. Additionally, when room is unavailable for planting the required trees on-site, or planting on-site would create nuisance or hazard trees, then they may be planted at another location or a payment of \$500 per tree credit may be made into the City Tree Fund.
