INVITATION TO BID**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the City of Woodinville will receive sealed bids in the office of the City Clerk at Woodinville City Hall, 17301 133<sup>rd</sup> Avenue NE, Woodinville, WA 98072 until **11:00 am, local time on January 31, 2018** at which time bids will be opened. Bids received later than **11:00 am, January 31, 2018** shall not be considered.

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** The work to be performed under this contract shall include improvements of Sammamish Bridge Replacement Project. This project will widen SR 202 (NE 175th St.) from the intersection of 131st Avenue NE (MP 0.31) to Woodinville-Redmond Road (MP 0.55). This segment of SR 202 will be widened to 4 lanes by constructing a new two-lane bridge adjacent to the existing bridge. Railing and sidewalk modification are also included for the existing bridge. In addition, bike lanes, curb and gutter and sidewalk will be installed on both sides of the road, surveying, storm drainage, roadway excavation and embankment, planing, hot mix paving, traffic control, traffic signals, railroad signals and gates, street lighting, pavement markings, retaining walls, landscaping, and other work, all in accordance with the Specifications and Contract Documents entitled: **“Sammamish Bridge Replacement Project, PW03-0103”**.
